



PHILOSOPHY


Our teachers are fully trained on the Griggs philosophy. Teachers continuously reflect on how our teaching meets the mission of Griggs to:

Training on the Griggs teaching methodology provides our teachers with the tools to provide a unique learner experience and exposes students to learning that will build upon previous knowledge and allow students to make not only personal connections, but local and global connections too.

The Griggs concepts of the Key Values, Incorporating Local Culture and Making Cross-curriculum Connections are intertwined, and our teaching should reflect that. These concepts and connections should be taught using the Griggs learning approaches of Active Constructivism, Learning, Content Integrated Learning, Language Differentiation to reinforce the Learner Profile of Seekers of Knowledge, Affirmers of Values and Changers of the World.

This methodology allows students to develop a natural curiosity for learning. It enables them to apply knowledge and thinking skills critically and creatively to recognize and approach complex problems to make reasoned, and ethical decisions and ensures they can express their ideas with facts, confidently and creatively, working effectively and willingly in collaboration with others.







SAFEGUARDING

Our students are important to us as is their wellbeing. All of our teachers undergo initial safeguarding training to ensure the learning environment for students is safe, accessible and promotes not only academic achievement but also personal growth.

Teachers are also trained in the positive management of behavior, with a focus on accountability of behavior, mental health awareness and ensuring an open forum to discuss issues.

Mental health awareness training is paramount to support all students regardless of circumstances. Teachers receive ongoing training to support students, to ensure all students receive an education that empowers them.
